

Walks at Gluepot

WALK	NAME OF WALK	DISTANCE	FEATURES
W1	MALLEEFOWL	5.5 km return	Malleefowl mound, <i>Callitris</i> (pine) woodland, regrowth from 2006 fires
W2	GRASSWREN	6.5 km circuit	Old growth mallee, Mallee/ <i>Triodia</i> (spinifex) dunes
W3	BLUEBUSH	10.5 km circuit	Long unburnt vegetation, variety of habitats
W4	OIL LINE	15 km circuit, 6 & 10 km options	Variety of habitats
W5S	BABBLER CAMP SOUTH	2.7 km circuit	Mallee/ <i>Triodia</i> (spinifex) dunes <i>Casuarina</i> (black oak) woodland
W5N	BABBLER CAMP NORTH	3.2 km circuit	Mallee/ <i>Triodia</i> (spinifex) dunes <i>Casuarina</i> (black oak) woodland
W6	BIG SAND DUNE	10.6 km out and back	Tall sand dune, views Variety of habitats
W7	BLACK OAK SWAMP	6.5 km circuit 4.5 km option	<i>Casuarina</i> (black oak) woodland Mallee/ <i>Triodia</i> (spinifex) dunes
W8	GYPSUM LUNETTE	5.5 km circuit	Gypsum lunette from ancient lake, Mallee/ <i>Triodia</i> (spinifex) dunes
W9	BROGGY'S HOLE	6 km circuit	Variety of habitats
W10	AIRSTRIP	950m circuit	Rarely inundated seasonal clay pan, Low scrubland, Large area of <i>Eremophila</i>
W11	BOTANIC WALK	850m	Common plants of Gluepot
W12	WHISTLER	6.0 km circuit	Bird hide, water point, passes home dams
W13	OLD GLUEPOT HERITAGE WALK	1.5 km	Remains of Old Gluepot homestead

Allow an hour or more for each 3 km – especially if there are lots of birds present.

All trails are easy walking, though all but W10 and W13 have some softer sandy sections.

Remember your GPS, compass, water bottle and hat – and enjoy your walk
